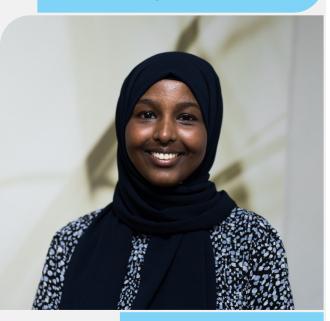

- We take part in and support initiatives designed to help young people into meaningful work
